1.as per the comments No 3. Theoretical framework must discuss the ideas of learning, language learning and use of strategies and models. This is not well done. Curriculum is not theory. It is also not necessary to harp on the fact that students want to learn English. It also ends abruptly.

## Not a word has been changed from the original. That is not a revision.

- 2. According to the comment No. 4. Review of literature. Any research paper must present a critical review of previous significant research dealing with the issue: in this case, learning English as a second language. There are a lot of such research and most major ones must be discussed, particularly those that have dealt with such issues in Indonesia. 12-15 references are needed. Please download the guidelines from the website and follow suit. Just listing or mentioning them is not enough. It should be a 'critical review'. Use the author's voice. This has been ignored.
- 3. On research methods see comment 5. This must explain tools of gathering data. This should not be a lecture on research methods, but what was done step by step. It is not about what can be done or what data can be gathered or their benefits. Say who did what when and where to get data. Be specific. Avoid vague terms such as 'some' and 'various'. This research employs an experimental method, which is explained reasonably well. However, it is
